NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY MIRACLE MILE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS) WORK PLAN

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the feasibility study (FS) work plan to implement the FS for the Miracle Mile Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Tucson, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-404(C)(1)(d)]. An FS is conducted to identify a reference remedy and alternative remedies that appear to be capable of achieving established remedial objectives and to evaluate them based on the comparison criteria to select a remedy.

The Miracle Mile WQARF site consists of plumes located in Tucson. The plumes are bounded approximately by Wetmore Road to the north, Prince Road to the south, Pomona Road to the east, and La Cholla Boulevard to the west. Contaminants of concern at the site are trichloroethene and chromium in groundwater and hexavalent chromium in subsurface soil.
