

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 90-DAY COMMENT PERIOD
WEST CENTRAL PHOENIX WEST GRAND AVENUE
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
PROPOSED REMEDIAL ACTION PLAN (PRAP)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the proposed remedial action plan (PRAP) for the West Central Phoenix West Grand Avenue Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Phoenix, Arizona [Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-408(C)]. The PRAP documents the results of the remedial investigation/feasibility study (RI/FS) and identifies the proposed remedy and its estimated costs.

The West Central Phoenix West Grand Avenue WQARF site consisted of a plume located in Phoenix. The plume was bounded approximately by Osborn Road to the north, Earll Drive to the south, 33rd Avenue to the east, and 34th Drive to the west. Contaminant of concern at the site was trichloroethene (TCE).

The proposed remedy for the site is as follows: collect two rounds of groundwater samples. If contaminant of concern is still less than the Aquifer Water Quality Standard (AWQS) of 5 micrograms per liter ($\mu\text{g/L}$) wells will be abandoned and the site delisted. The estimated cost to implement this remedy is approximately \$32,500 for a period of less than one year. Previous costs accrued by ADEQ total \$607,015.46.

Additionally, a Community Advisory Board (CAB) meeting will be held during the comment period at which time interested parties will be given an opportunity to comment on the PRAP. CAB meeting information will be sent to the site mailing list and posted on the ADEQ website. All comments received will be compiled in a responsiveness summary to be included in the record of decision for the site. **Comments must be postmarked or received by ADEQ no later than 5 p.m. on Wednesday, April 20, 2016.**
