## NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF THE FINAL REMEDIAL INVESTIGATION REPORT FOR THE MIRACLE MILE WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND REGISTRY SITE

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has completed the Final Remedial Investigation (RI) Report for the Miracle Mile WQARF Registry Site in Tucson, Arizona (A.A.C. R18-16-406(J)). An RI Report is prepared to identify the nature, extent, and sources of contaminated soil and waters of the state; identify current and potential impacts to public health, welfare and the environment; identify present and reasonably foreseeable uses of land and waters of the state; and obtain and evaluate any other information necessary for identification and comparison of alternative remedial actions. The Final RI Report includes the Final Remedial Objectives Report and responsiveness summaries regarding comments, issues and concerns raised during the community involvement process.

The Miracle Mile WQARF Registry Site consists of a trichloroethene groundwater plume bounded approximately by Wetmore Road to the north, Flowing Wells Road to the east, Prince Road to the south, and La Cholla Boulevard to the west. The site boundaries provide the estimated extent of currently known contamination. The current contaminants of concern are trichloroethene and chromium in the groundwater and hexavalent chromium in subsurface soil. Contaminants of concern at the site may change as new data become available.
