



**PUBLIC NOTICE  
PROPOSED PLAN FOR  
AIR FORCE PLANT 44, TUSCON ARIZONA  
SR932 – 1980s PISTOL RANGE**

The United States Air Force (USAF) announces the availability of the Proposed Plan for No Further Action (NFA) at the site known as the 1980's Pistol Range (SR932) Munitions Response Site at Air Force Plant 44, Tucson Arizona. The non-time critical removal action (NTCRA) removed the hazards associated with surface and near-surface lead contaminated soils at the site. The site can now be closed to residential standards, allowing Unlimited Use of the site and Unrestricted Exposure to the soil (UU/UE).

**The Proposed Plan is available for public review during the public comment period. The original public comment period of September 17 to October 16, 2014, has been extended based on input from the community during the public meeting held on October 15, 2014. The public comment period now extends to December 10, 2014. The Proposed Plan is available for review at the following location:**
