

**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY AND 30 DAY COMMENT PERIOD
PARK - EUCLID
WATER QUALITY ASSURANCE REVOLVING FUND (WQARF) SITE
FEASIBILITY STUDY (FS)**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) has received from the Park - Euclid Group (the Group) an application for approval of a feasibility study (FS) report for the Park - Euclid Water Quality Assurance Revolving Fund (WQARF) site in Tucson, Arizona pursuant to Arizona Administrative Code R18-16-413(A)&(D). An FS was conducted that identified a reference remedy and alternative remedies that are capable of achieving established remedial objectives and evaluated them based on the comparison criteria to select a proposed remedy.

The Park - Euclid WQARF site consists of a plume and contaminant source located in Tucson. The plume is bounded approximately by 8th Street on the north, 14th Street on the south, Mountain Avenue on the east, and Park Avenue on the west. The contaminants of concern at the site are tetrachloroethene (PCE), trichloroethene (TCE), *cis*-1,2-dichloroethene (*cis*-1,2-DCE), *trans*-1,2-dichloroethene (*trans*-1,2-DCE), and vinyl chloride.
