


I write to confirm two commitments by the stakeholders listed above with respect to the West Van Buren WQARF Site.

First, the stakeholders are prepared to conduct immediately a formal Feasibility Study ("FS") for the West Van Buren WQARF Site. We would be happy to execute an agreement to formalize our commitment. We suggest a meeting with you and/or members of your staff as soon as possible to ensure that our proposed work meets the Agency's expectations.

Second, we commit to you that we will develop and implement an appropriate early response action ("ERA") if new sampling data and other relevant information demonstrate that such an ERA is necessary to protect public health and welfare during the time required to develop the FS and implement the remedy. As you know, we do not believe the existing data support such an action, and further that the Roosevelt Irrigation District's ERA proposal in particular is fatally flawed. We do, however, understand that a new round of data collection will be initiated in the near future at the RID wells and canals. We trust that ADEQ will ensure that the data are credible, based on a sound quality assurance and quality control plan, and are evaluated considering actual pumping conditions. Following this round of sampling, we would be happy to revisit whether an

ERA is necessary. Again, if the new sampling data and other relevant information demonstrate that an appropriate ERA is necessary, we will implement it.
