1. Call to Order / Introductions – Brenda Holland, CAG Co-Chair

Ms. Holland, CAG Co-Chair, facilitated the meeting. CAG members and all meeting attendees introduced themselves.

2. CAG vote on Crane Co. letter-Brenda Holland, CAG-Co-Chair

Ms. Amos motioned and Ms. Kagan seconded the motion to accept the CAG letter to be sent to Crane Co., with enclosed supplemental information and the CAG members' suggested formatting edits. The motion passed unanimously by the CAG. The letter will be signed by both Co-Chairs.

3. Update on community involvement activities and future CAG actions-Diane Krone, CAG Co-Chair

The CAG requested to have a dialogue with Crane Co. representatives at their next CAG meeting on Thursday, February 10, 2011. They proposed that an agenda item titled "CAG discussion with Crane Co. representatives" be added to the February 10, 2011, meeting agenda. They agreed to

submit their questions for Crane Co. to Ms. Calderon to be consolidated and sent in advance to Crane Co.

Ms. Holland and Ms. Krone stated that CAG engagement needs to be increased within the communities to promote their interest of site activities. The CAG discussed media outlets to raise awareness of the CAG and its efforts. The CAG talked about a CAG presentation packet to be created for its members to present at outreach events e.g. HOAs, schools, etc. Ms. Krone volunteered to work with Nadine Johnson to create a PowerPoint presentation on the history of the site and a quick reference brochure for the CAG presentation packet. Items for the CAG presentation packet will be presented to the CAG for their review and vote.

Nadine Johnson requested CAG members contact her for their input on qualities they would like in a Technical Assistant (TA) for the site.

Mr. Iwanski expressed the City's support including the Acting Mayor and City Manager for the CAG's efforts and dedication to the remediation of the sites.

4.*Call to the Public

Ms. Gibbons stated that she wanted to speak further with project management staff regarding the remediation history of the sites. Ms. Gibbons expressed her frustration on the progression of the plume and negligence that has allowed for its migration. Ms. Kagan directed Ms. Gibbons to the site repository located at the Sam Garcia Public Library for site history. Ms. Calderon also offered ADEQ and U.S. EPA's Web sites as resources related to the remediation history for the sites.
