ADEQ to play host to 2014 Annual Emission Inventory Workshop for Yuma Area on Monday, April 14

PHOENIX (April 2, 2014) – Arizona Department of Environmental Quality officials announced today that the 2014 Annual Emission Inventory Workshop for the City of Yuma and surrounding Yuma County area will be conducted on Monday, April 14 at the Yuma County Library in Training Room A, 2951 S. 21st Dr.

The free workshop will have three separate sessions. The first, from 10 a.m. until noon, will focus on using the State and Local Emission Inventory System (SLEIS) that Arizona uses for emission inventory reporting. The second, from 1 p.m.-3 p.m., is targeted for the rock products industry and addresses the most common air quality violations and how to stay in compliance. The third, from 3 p.m. until 5 p.m., is about how to use ADEQ's Excel files for emission reporting.
