ADEQ to play host to 2014 Annual Emission Inventory Workshop for Tucson Area on Monday, April 21

PHOENIX (April 8, 2014) – Arizona Department of Environmental Quality officials announced today that the 2014 Annual Emission Inventory Workshop for the City of Tucson and Pima County will be conducted on Monday, April 21 in Room 444 of ADEQ’s Southern Regional Office in Tucson, 400 W. Congress Street.

The free workshop will have two separate sessions. The first, from 10 a.m. until noon, will focus on emission inventory reporting using the State and Local Emission Inventory System (SLEIS) and ADEQ’s Excel reporting forms. The second, from 1 p.m.-3 p.m., is targeted for the rock products industry and addresses the most common air quality violations and how to stay in compliance.
