ADEQ to play host to Hazardous Waste Workshops for Yuma and Surrounding Area on Tuesday, April 22

PHOENIX (April 8, 2014) – Arizona Department of Environmental Quality officials announced today that two free hazardous waste workshop sessions for residents of Yuma County and other parts of western Arizona will be conducted on Tuesday, April 22 in the City of Yuma Utilities Meeting Room, 155 W. 14th Street.

The presentations will be held from 9 a.m. until 11 a.m. and from 1 p.m. until 3 p.m. Each of the sessions will cover the same material, with presentations on Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and hazardous waste regulations, hazardous waste generator statutes, common hazardous wastes by industry, what to expect when you are inspected, top 10 most common hazardous waste violations, and the new ADEQ hazardous waste inspection checklist.
